The Challenge

With a worldwide customer base, Cummins Generator Technologies in Peterborough, England often found itself playing host to employee, user and vendor conferences, with upwards of 190 people attending at one time. That meant meeting room conditions were often overworked, with smells from food taking over, and stale air creating an undesirable-and unhealthyenvironment. What's more, these issues were impacting the perception of the company among employees and guests.
